
TEACHER REQUEST

June 7th — Annual Murphy Golf Outing at Metamora Country Club


Last week registration forms were sent home for our annual Murphy Golf Outing at Metamora Country Club on June 7th. Throughout the school year parents are often bombarded with different fundraisers and collections for various good causes, but nothing provides more directly for Murphy students than the golf outing. Over the last 10 years, we have raised a total of <u>over \$50,000</u> through the golf event alone!

This past year, we purchased 30 iPads for the students due in large part to funding that was raised. The kids and staff have embraced this new technology and students have never been more engaged with these 21st century tools. It is our hope to be able to purchase 60 new iPads, two power sync carts, and valuable internet based software that allows students to learn at their own pace.

For \$300 a team (\$75 a person) you will get a full round of golf, a great lunch buffet, and the chance to win some terrific prizes. When I say prizes, we don't just mean a couple golf balls, but hot air balloon rides, golf packages, dinners, and even a Ray C's, ATV! Every participant will get their own Murphy Lightning cooler as well. The outing is a scramble format, so even the worst golfers will have a great time. Just ask me, I'm terrible and have a blast at golf outings!

The best part is, 100% of the profits will go directly toward the technology purchases for the 2014-2015 school year. We have a goal at Murphy Elementary to be able to put one iPad, laptop, or a tablet in every student's hand within five years.
